FINANCIAL REPORT

The Interim Financial reports for the month of 30 April 2023 are attached. The year-end financial statements and audit are still being finalised so these reports are interim.

The net Operating surplus for the month is \$2,763. The overall result is \$53,809, which reflects the positive unrealised movement in the market value of the Investment portfolio of \$51,046 for the month of April.

Key points to note:

Income

- a) The JB Were investment portfolio income for the month was \$9,993.
- b) Premises income includes croquet functions and hire of apartment during tournaments.

Balance Sheet

- c) Net Assets at 30 April were \$8,867,499. The movement in Net Assets for the month was an increase of \$53,809.
- d) See attachment for a summary page of the JB Were portfolio at 30 April showing the value of \$4,802,905, an increase of \$52,494 since the end of March.

Cash Outlook

The operating bank account is \$125k at month end. This compares to approx. \$126k at the same point last year. At this stage there is no foreseeable need to draw any amounts from the Investment portfolio for at least the next quarter.

Finance sub-committee report - The Finance sub-committee is scheduled to meet on 16 May to review the draft financial statements and audit report. I will provide a verbal update at the COM meeting.
